



(5) Connect with others through the discussion room

You can exchange opinions on the Learning Network using the discussion function.




In the Discussion Room, learners can post photos and exchange opinions.

Discussion rooms are created for each topic, so you can set up notifications to receive emails about new posts in discussion rooms that interest you.




Let's check out how to use it.

Click "Discussion" in the menu on the right side of the relevant class.



When you open the "Open Discussions" tab, you'll see a list of all currently available discussion rooms.


By selecting a room that interests you, you can view the conversations that have taken place within it.




At the top of this discussion room is an explanation, and comments are displayed on the left side.

Photos and attached files will be displayed with their file names on the right side of each comment.


You can also react to other people's comments using the heart-shaped like button.



To post a comment, click the "send" button at the bottom of the page.




Enter your comments, select the file if you have one, and click the "Send" button.



If you add a discussion room for a topic you are interested in to your "watchlist", you will receive an email when new comments are posted.


Additionally, they will also appear in the "Watchlist" section of the Discussion Room list.

You can remove a discussion room from your watchlist by clicking "Remove from discussion watchlist".



You can also apply to create a new discussion room for a topic by clicking the "Apply for New Discussion Room" button.

Your request will be processed after administrator approval.

The chatbot can also respond to questions in languages other than Japanese and English.
